5th Avenue: Construction of the 5th Avenue Improvement Project between Washington Street and Van Buren Street will be complete October 12, 2020.




SPECIAL TRAFFIC CHANGE NOTICE

Beginning Monday, October 12, 2020 5th Avenue: Washington Street to Van Buren Street will be changed to two-way traffic with one lane in each direction. This traffic change will allow a temporary bus route utilizing 5th Avenue in conjunction with the Light Rail project.

What to Expect:

- Existing **two-way traffic** condition **will remain** in place between Washington Street and Adams Street.
- **One-way traffic** condition from Adams Street to Van Buren Street will be **changed to two-way traffic** with associated turns and signals.
- 5th Avenue **north of Van Buren Street** will remain a **one-way southbound traffic** condition with associated restrictions and signage.

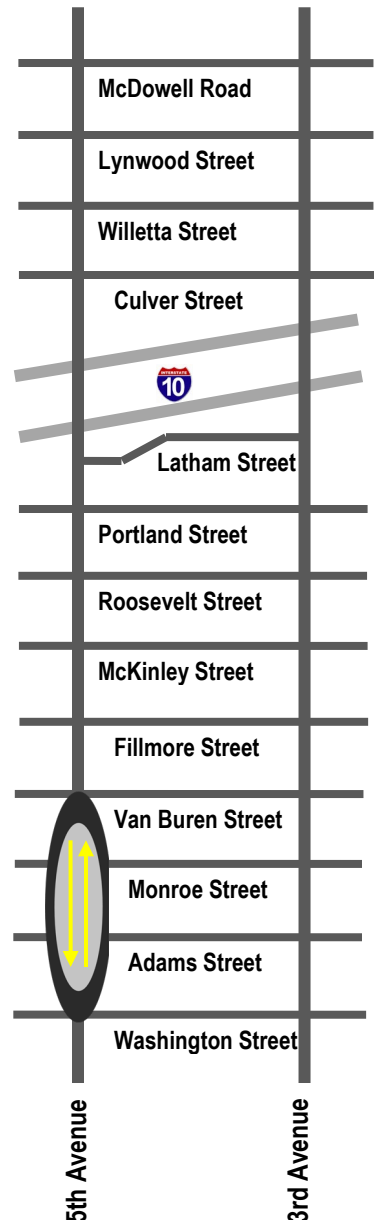
Map Key
