Construction Starting

3rd Avenue:

On Monday, August 24, 2020, construction activities will begin at the intersection of **3rd Avenue and Roosevelt Street**, and will include:

- Removal and replacement of existing concrete ramps, curb, gutter, and sidewalk.
- Construction of two new catch basins, storm drain pipe and manhole on the northwest corner.
- Removal of existing traffic signals and installation of the new pedestrian and Cycle Track Signal, and associated foundations, signal poles, junction boxes, video detection, wireless radio, CCTV camera, and 8-phase signals and controllers.
- Restoration of existing brick pavers on the northeast corner north to the driveway, and new concrete pavers on the southeast and northwest corners. Existing trees will remain.

What to Expect:

- Work hours will generally be Monday - Friday 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some weekend work may occur.
- Traffic restrictions will be in place including lane closures and turn restrictions.
- On-street parking may be restricted in the contractor's work area.
- Alternate routes are encouraged whenever possible.

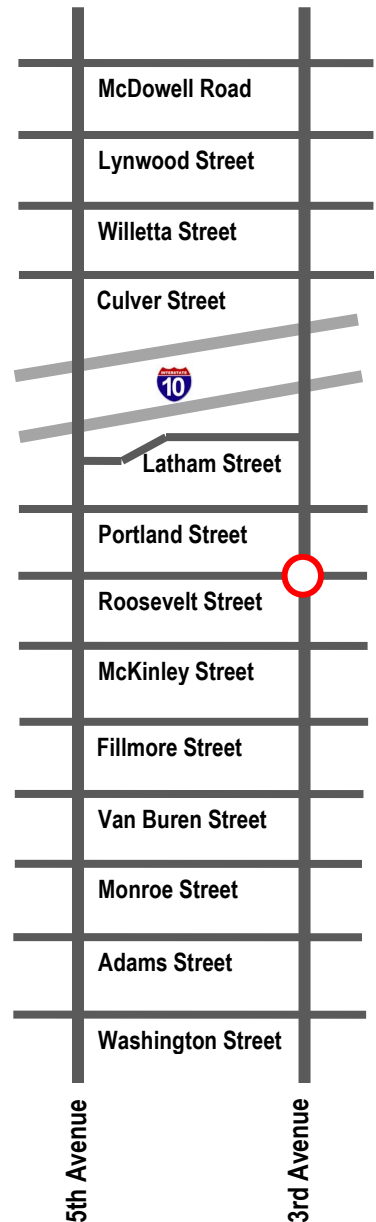
Impacted Work Areas █
