

PROJECT UPDATE July 2021

Pinnacle Peak Road: 45th Avenue to 35th Avenue

Thank you for your patience during the recent work by the City of Phoenix Water Services Department, which included the installation of a new water main distribution line. This project was a necessary first step before the Street Transportation Department could install a new storm drain system and reconstruct the pavement along Pinnacle Peak Road.

More construction is coming to your area, but we will work to minimize as much inconvenience as possible. Construction work is inconvenient but necessary. The Street Transportation project is slated to begin in September or October and will last for about a year. In the meantime, you can enjoy a brief break from construction activity. We hope this anticipated schedule will avoid our crews doing construction during the worst of the monsoon storms.

Roadway Improvements & Repaving

- New storm drain pipe, catch basins and box culverts, (box culverts direct water flows safely under the road in low-lying areas),
- New sidewalks, curbs and gutters,
- New street lighting,
- New, modernized traffic signals at 39th Drive and at 43rd Avenue with flashing yellow arrows to expedite left turns,
- Landscaping improvements, and
- Repaving of Pinnacle Peak Road between 45th Avenue and 35th Avenue.

When complete, you and your neighbors will enjoy the street improvements on a new pavement surface and drainage issues will be mitigated.
