Autumn represents Tierra Strategy as a public interest policy advocate before regulators, legislators, and other policymakers in Arizona, as well as a sustainability consultant for organizations. Her work is primarily focused on advancing clean energy resources; moving the power sector away from fossil-fueled resources; transportation electrification; and developing regulatory and statutory mechanisms to address climate change.
