SAMPLE BALLOT PAMPHLET

On Tuesday, Nov. 8, 2011, the City of Phoenix will conduct a Runoff Election in which city voters will elect a mayor and voters in Districts 1 and 5 will elect a council member. This election is required by the City Charter because no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for their respective offices in the August Election.

A Sample Ballot Pamphlet will be mailed the week of October 3 to each residence address in the city where there is a registered voter unless a voter has requested to obtain the Pamphlet electronically. The Pamphlet will list the early voting locations and the dates and times each are available. The Sample Ballot Pamphlet also is available at phoenix.gov/ELECTION/voteidx.html or from the City Clerk Department.

Voters can vote at any of the 26 voting centers located throughout the City. A list and map of the Voting Centers is available on the Web at phoenix.gov/election and in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet. For additional assistance locating a voting center that is convenient, voters can call the Election Information Line listed below.

Alternative Formats

To ensure voting privacy, convenience and accessibility, the Phoenix City Clerk Department offers extensive services to accommodate the voting needs of residents with disabilities. The City Clerk Department will provide the Sample Ballot Pamphlet in alternative formats, including Braille, large print and computer diskette, upon request. Requests must be **received** no later than Friday, October 14.
