VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

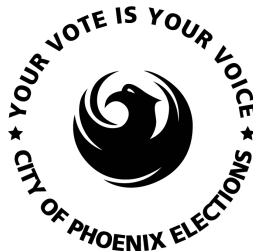
Monday, Oct. 10 is the last day to register to vote for the Nov. 2011 City of Phoenix Runoff Election. In this Election, city voters will elect a Mayor and voters in Districts 1 and 5 will elect a council member. This election is required by the City Charter because no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for these offices in the August Election.

County and State offices will be closed on Oct. 10 for the Columbus Day Holiday; therefore, voters are encouraged to register prior to Oct. 10, or to use servicearizona.com to register on Oct. 10.

To be eligible to vote, a person must be a registered voter and reside within the City at least 29 days immediately prior to this election.

Voter registration forms are available at most libraries and government facilities, including the City Clerk Department on the 15th Floor of Phoenix City Hall, 200 W. Washington St. Registration forms also are available from the County Recorder's Office at recorder.maricopa.gov/web/regform.aspx.
