SAMPLE BALLOT PAMPHLET

The City of Phoenix will hold a Council Election on September 1 for voters in Council Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8 to elect Council Members. A Sample Ballot Pamphlet will be mailed the week of July 27 to each residence address in these districts where there is a registered voter. It will identify the voter's polling place and early and accessible voting locations. The Sample Ballot Pamphlet also is available at phoenix.gov/ELECTION/voteidx.html or from the City Clerk Department.

There is no election in Council Districts 1, 3, 5, or 7 because the terms of the council members are staggered and there is no election for mayor or propositions this year.

Alternative Formats

To ensure voting privacy, convenience and accessibility, the Phoenix City Clerk Department offers extensive services to accommodate the voting needs of residents with disabilities. The City Clerk Department will provide the Sample Ballot Pamphlet in alternative formats, including Braille, large print and computer diskette, upon request. Requests must be **received** no later than Friday, August 7.
