Early Voting Starts

Early voting for the City of Phoenix Council Election starts on Aug. 3. In this election, registered voters in Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8 will elect Council Members. There is no election in Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7 because the terms of the council members are staggered and there is no election for mayor or propositions this year.

The deadline to register to vote in this election is Monday, Aug. 3.

Early Voting by Mail

Voters in Phoenix Council Districts 2, 4, 6 and 8 who are on the permanent early voting list will be mailed an early ballot unless they have elected not to receive one for this election. Voters in these districts who are not on the permanent early voting list may request an early ballot by mail by submitting a signed, written request to the City Clerk Department. Request forms are available at phoenix.gov/ELECTION/voteidx.html, at city public service counters and libraries, or by calling the City Clerk Department, Elections Division. Early ballot requests must be **received** by the City Clerk Department no later than 5 p.m. Friday, Aug. 21.

Early Voting Locations and Accessible Voting Equipment

Several early voting sites will be available throughout the city for voters to cast an early ballot or exchange a damaged or spoiled early ballot received by mail. Accessible voting devices that permit voters with disabilities to vote independently will be available at these sites. The list of locations, with the dates and times each are open, can be found in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet, by calling the City Clerk Department at the number below or at phoenix.gov/ELECTION/voteidx.html.
