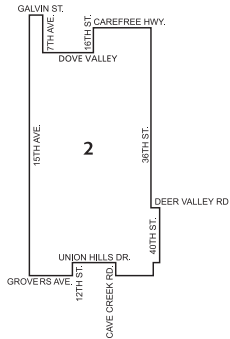
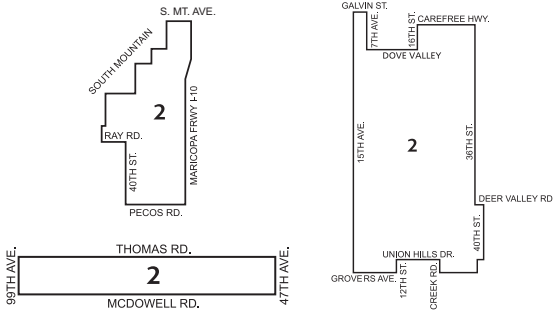

BULK TRASH COLLECTION

AREA 2 BEGINS DEC. 15

Bulk Trash must be placed out by 6 a.m. 12-15-08



AREA 3 BEGINS DEC. 22

Four times a year city crews collect bulk trash such as tree limbs, palm fronds, some large appliances and discarded furniture. All vegetation must be less than four feet long and 12 inches in diameter.

A joint-use library is being constructed on the South Mountain Community College campus by South Mountain Community College and Phoenix Public Library. This 56,000-square-foot facility is funded by the 2006 Phoenix Citizen's Bond Program and the 2004 Maricopa Community College District Bond Program. Construction begins in 2010 and, when complete, the new library will offer programs and materials for children, teens and adults.
