

**CITY OF PHOENIX
 FINAL PROGRAM OF PROJECTS FOR THE
 AMERICAN RECOVERY & REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009
 FTA APPLICATION FOR
 49 U.S.C. §5307, §5309 FUNDED PROJECTS**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Phoenix Public Transit Department held a public hearing on behalf of the Phoenix and Avondale urbanized area on April 16, 2009 at the Public Transit Department, 302 N. First Avenue, Phoenix Arizona.

The purpose of this hearing was to solicit and consider public comment on applications for capital projects for which financial assistance is being sought from the Federal Transit Administration, pursuant to 49 U.S.C.

The City of Phoenix makes the applications on behalf of the region as the designated recipient of federal transit funds for the urbanized area. Funds will be passed through to the subrecipients via contracts.

This is the final proposed program of projects with one revised request.
