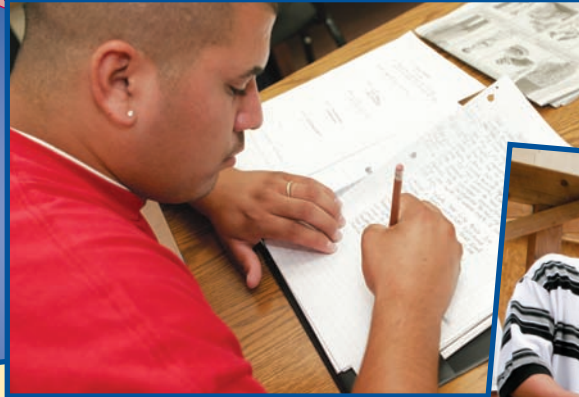




# Get Paid While Earning Your GED
