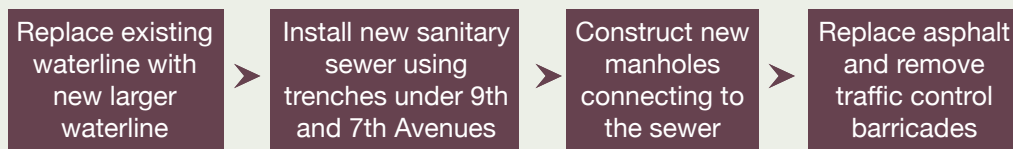

Broadway Road, 9th Avenue to 7th Avenue Restricted August 2011 – December 2011

What work is being done?



Work hours: 6 a.m. and 7 p.m. Monday through Friday.
Crews will likely arrive on site as early as 5:30 a.m.
Weekend work will be necessary at intersections.

What traffic and access impacts can be expected during construction?

- Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction on Broadway Road. Traffic control barricades will be in place 24-hours a day, seven days a week.
- Access to business driveways will be maintained throughout the project. In locations where there are multiple access driveways, one may be closed at times. Restrictions will occur as the main is installed past driveways.
- No parking will be permitted on Broadway Road. Use only designated parking spaces.
- Future restrictions will occur on Broadway Road between 7th Avenue and 17th Street through October 2012.

What can be done to help keep the project on schedule?

- Drive carefully around the construction site, and use alternate streets when possible to access businesses and residences.
- Keep children and pets away from construction activities and equipment to maintain a safe work zone.
- Watch message boards on site for closure dates.
- Call or email us with questions or concerns.
