## 38<sup>th</sup> Drive to 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue Restricted week of January 19, 2009 – February 2009

- Traffic will be restricted on Broadway Road to local traffic only.
- Northbound and southbound lanes will remain open on 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- The traffic restrictions will be in place for approximately six weeks starting the week of January 19, 2009 and ending February 2009.
- Local traffic will need to use side streets to access their homes/business.
- If your business has only one driveway, access will be provided.
- The crew will be on site around 6:00 a.m. with heavy construction beginning around 6:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. Monday – Thursday. Additional or extended work may occur Friday – Sunday.
- Please do not park on the street.
- It is very important for safety reasons to keep children and pets away from construction activities and equipment.
- Watch message boards for actual closure dates.
- Broadway Road will be paved following the sewer line installation.
