33rd Avenue to 10th Avenue

Traffic Restrictions

- Traffic will be heavily restricted adjacent to the contractor's work area. Local businesses and residents will have at least one access point maintained at all times.
- Driveway access may be temporarily restricted during trenching and pipe installation as the contractor crosses the driveways. Businesses and residents will be notified prior to any driveway restrictions.
- There will be no parking in non-designated areas within the City of Phoenix right-of-way on the north and south side of Broadway Road during construction.
- Street intersection closures and restrictions may occur during utility relocation, trenching, and pipe installation. Businesses and residents will be notified prior to these restrictions.

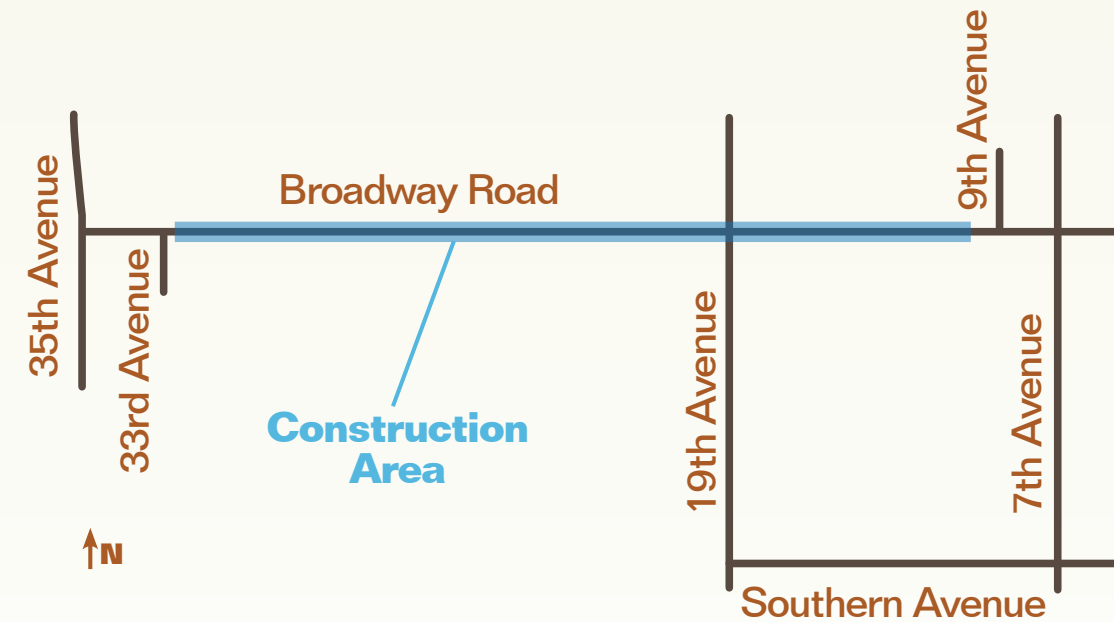

Phase 2B Construction Activities

The City of Phoenix Water Services Department (Department) will install approximately 14,000 feet of new, larger sanitary sewer main in the public right-of-way on Broadway Road with increased capacity for the next 50 years to support future growth. The new sewer main will be installed using a combination of open-trench and trenchless (underground tunneling) construction methods. Additionally, approximately 1,400-feet of 8-inch waterline will be installed between 19th and 17th avenues.

Trenchless construction allows the Department to minimize the impact the sewer installation will have on the traveling public, and businesses and residents. However, it is significantly more expensive than open-trench installation and is therefore only being used in areas where open-trench construction would cause substantial disruption to existing utilities and traffic. The areas identified for trenchless construction are roughly 27th Avenue to 19th Avenue and 17th Avenue to 15th Avenue.



It is very important for safety reasons to keep children and pets away from construction activities and equipment.

We are committed to proactive planning for the needs of our community.

We are committed to protecting and enhancing community health and the environment with a sound, safe sewer infrastructure with sufficient capacity to meet the future needs of the City of Phoenix.

Project Schedule*

- Construction is anticipated to be 15 months beginning July 2009.
- Anticipated work hours will be 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. May 1 through September 30 and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. October 1 through April 30.
- Construction will occur Monday through Friday, although some night and weekend work may occur.
