Broadway Road, 33rd Avenue to 27th Avenue Restricted Mid July - Mid September

- Traffic will be restricted on Broadway Road to local traffic only.
- One travel lane in each direction will remain open on Broadway Road.
- The traffic restrictions will be in place for approximately two months.
- Please follow traffic control signage regarding local access to businesses and residences.
- If your business has only one driveway on Broadway Road, access will be provided through coordination efforts provided by on-site superintendent.
- There will be no parking in the right-of-way on Broadway Road.
- The crew will be on site around 5:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. Additional or extended weekend work hours may occur.
- It is very important for safety reasons to keep children and pets away from construction activities and equipment.
- Watch message boards for actual closure dates.
- Broadway Road will be paved in segments following all underground installations.
