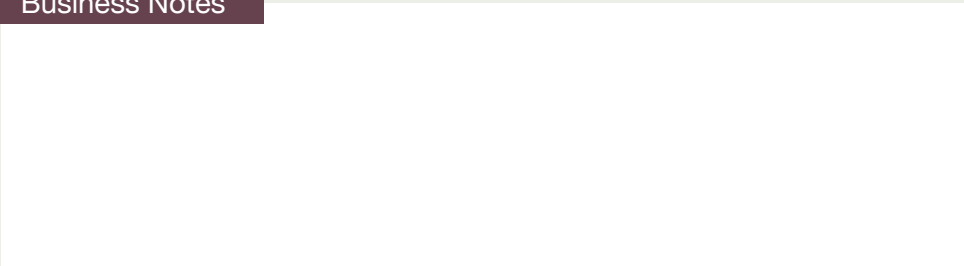

Business Notes



The City of Phoenix Water Services Department will be replacing the existing sanitary sewer main in Broadway Road with a new larger main as well as conducting adjacent improvements.

Business and Residential Access

Please do not park in the right-of-way on Broadway Road during construction. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times; however, restrictions may occur at times to complete the work. Please drive slowly and carefully through the barricades.

Construction Schedule

August 2011 - October 2012

- Work will begin the week of August 15, 2011 and be complete by October 2012.
- Work hours generally will be Monday - Friday, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 7 p.m. Hours will change depending on time of year.
- Weekend work will be necessary at intersections.
- Dates for specific segments are indicated on the map below but may change due to weather or underground conditions.



Paving of the sewer trench will occur at the completion of each segment.

- New 30" Sewer Main (Open Trench)
- Intersection Crossing (Trenchless/ Underground)
- Planned New Manhole (Approximate location)
