New Sewer Main Being Installed

The City of Phoenix Water Services Department will be replacing the existing sanitary sewer main along Broadway Road with a new, larger main with increased capacity to meet future wastewater flow demands. Installation of the new sanitary sewer main will include construction of new manholes, and relocation of water lines and storm drain lines. This project is scheduled to take approximately one year to complete.

Project Benefits

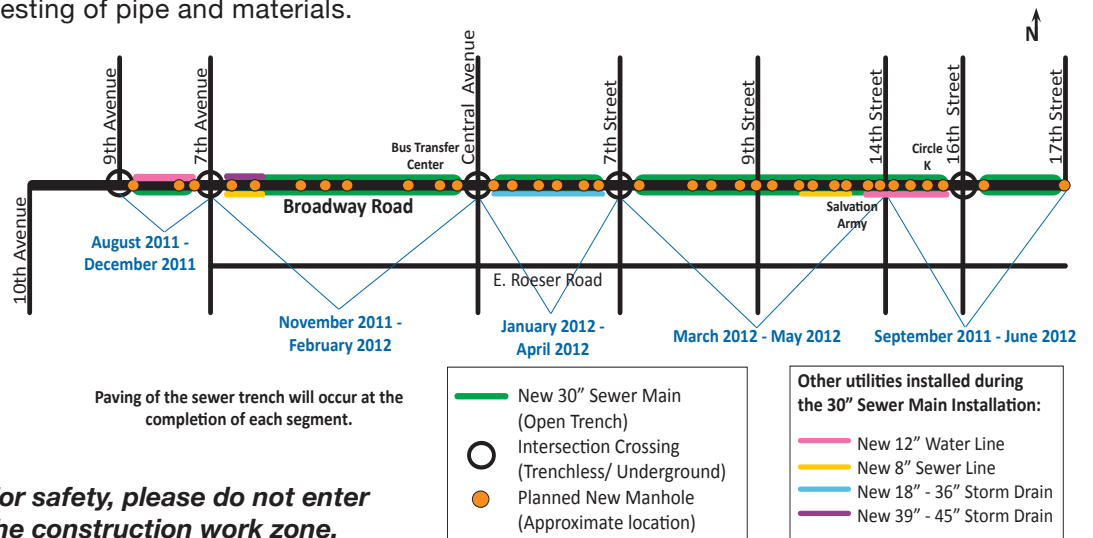
The new 30 inch sewer main will increase capacity, reduce turbulence and odors. Trenchless technology (construction underground) will be used for installation of the new sanitary sewer at five intersections (see map below) to reduce traffic impacts.

Details of Construction

- Work will begin the week of August 15, 2011 at 9th Avenue and Broadway Road. Work hours generally will be Monday - Friday, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 7 p.m. Extended or weekend work hours may be necessary.
- Traffic will be restricted on Broadway Road. Drivers are encouraged to use alternate routes as possible. Please allow for more time when traveling this route.
- Business access will be restricted around the construction zone. However, at least one access point will remain open at all times.
- More detailed construction notices will be distributed by work segment.

Construction Schedule (dates are subject to change)

The map below shows an estimated schedule beginning in August 2011 with multiple construction crews working simultaneously. New manholes (shown as an orange dot on the map) will be constructed as the sanitary sewer main is installed, but paving and completion of new manhole construction will follow due to concrete cure times and testing of pipe and materials.
