2004 SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

March 9: Tech. Rescue of two teens from South Mountain after 150-foot rappelling fall.
March 12: Phoenix Firehouse Store closes its doors.
March 27: PFD's Arson Dog, Zeus honored as 2004 Pet of the Year by Arizona Animal Welfare League.
April 10: Fire code requires Firefighter Air Systems in high rise and certain underground buildings. Arizona Public Service is first to install system.
May 31: 2-Alarm apartment fire with three burn victims at 17031 N. 11th Ave.
June 18: 3-Alarm arson fire at Oscar's Pallets Warehouse at 22nd Ave. & Durango.
June 25: 2-Alarm Medical as Tour Bus crashes while exiting at I-10 and 27th Ave.
July 4: APS' Westwing Substation fire destroys five transformer units, nearly sending Valley into rolling blackouts.
Oct. 9: 2-Alarm Fire/Haz Mat at Kool and Tuff auto supplies at 4301 N. 16th Street.
Aug. 28: 1st Alarm medical for multiple GSW victims, including Phoenix PD Officers Jason Wolfe and Eric White, killed in the line of duty.
Dec. 28: 2-Alarm fire at Cobblestone Apartments. Loss of \$1.8 million, 30 left homeless.
Dec. 30: 2-Alarm Medical - Construction Collapse at future car rental center at Sky Harbor Airport.
