

**CITY OF PHOENIX  
 FINAL PROGRAM OF PROJECTS FOR THE  
 ANNUAL APPLICATION FOR  
 49 U.S.C. §5307, §5309, §5316, §5317, CONGESTION MITIGATION AND  
 AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CMAQ),  
 AND SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP) FUNDED PROJECTS**

The City of Phoenix Public Transit Department held a public hearing on behalf of the Phoenix and Avondale urbanized area on Thursday, June 18, 2009 at the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG), 302 N. First Avenue, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor (Saguaro Room), Phoenix Arizona.

This was a joint public hearing with the Maricopa Association of Government's transportation improvement program (TIP) process. The public notice of public involvement activities and the time established for public review and comment was to satisfy the program-of-projects requirements of the urbanized Area Formula Program.

The purpose of this hearing was to solicit and consider public comment on applications for capital projects for which financial assistance is being sought from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), pursuant to 49 U.S.C.

The City of Phoenix makes the applications on behalf of the region as the designated recipient of federal transit funds for the urbanized area. Funds will be passed through to the subrecipients via contracts.

This is the final program of projects after consideration of comments received at the public hearing.
