**SUNNYSLOPE PASSENGERS SHOULD TAKE ADVANTAGE OF UPGRADED TRANSIT CENTER**

PHOENIX—Sunnyslope bus passengers will be pleased to know that their riding experience just got easier. **The upgraded Sunnyslope Transit Center is open for business, ready to serve customers who want to purchase fare media, get bus route information, bus time arrivals and departures and take advantage of Park-and-Ride.**

**The Sunnyslope Transit Center, located at 8927 N. Third St. (SE corner of Third and Dunlap),** has a staffed security station, 10 shaded seating areas, enhanced landscaping, closed-circuit TV security cameras, four bike lockers and 45 covered parking spaces for Park-and-Ride passengers. **Park-and-Ride is a convenient way for Sunnyslope bus riders to park their cars for free at the transit center,** and catch the bus to go to their destination. With Park-and-Ride, passengers enjoy a virtually traffic-free ride, and skip the steep parking fees elsewhere.

The transit center accepts cash, credit cards, personal and business checks and Travelers checks. Reduced fare IDs cannot be processed at this station.

**The current hours of operation for the Sunnyslope Transit Center are Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Closed on weekends and holidays.** The hours will be expanded as business grows.
