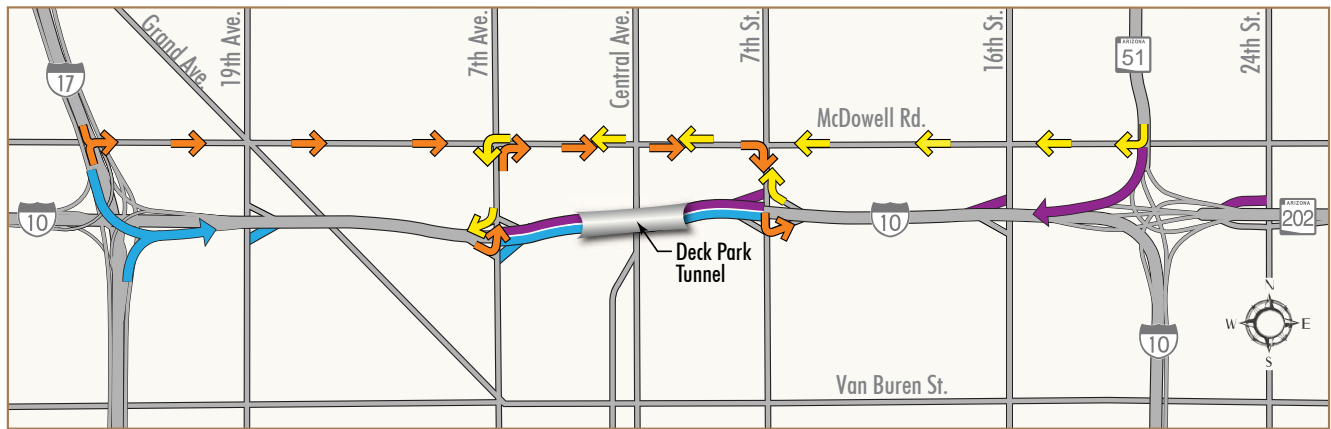
Weekend Closures in June and July

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) will be retrofitting the existing Fire Detection System (FDS) in the I-10 Deck Park Tunnel between 7th Avenue and 7th Street in June and July.

Four separate weekend closures of the Interstate 10 Deck Park Tunnel, freeway access ramps, and interchanges will be required in order to complete the project. No closures will occur on the Independence Day Holiday weekend Friday, July 3 – Monday, July 6.

Regional Interstate 10 travelers are encouraged to use I-17 as an alternate route through Phoenix during these closures.

- Westbound I-10 On-Ramp at 7th St.
