CONSOLIDATED PLAN REVIEW

The city of Phoenix has prepared draft documents of the 2015-20 Consolidated Plan, the 2015-16 Annual Action Plan (an element of the 2015-20 Consolidated Plan) and the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing.

The 2015-20 Consolidated Plan provides an assessment of the housing and community development needs in Phoenix over the next five years. The draft 2015-16 Annual Action Plan is the specific one-year plan for the use of the following U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula grant funds:

- Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships Program
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA)

The Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing is a review of barriers that affect the rights of fair housing choice.

The draft documents will be available for review and public comment from March 9 – April 9, 2015, at Phoenix City Hall, 200 W. Washington St., fourth floor. Documents can also be viewed at phoenix.gov/nsd/reports.

A public hearing will be held to view the draft documents at 5 p.m. April 7, 2015, at Phoenix City Hall, 200 W. Washington St., assembly room A.
