Open capacity for special projects and initiatives within your organization, gain critical professional experience as a supervisor, and make a lasting difference in a young person's life with the Phoenix ArtCorps, a new student employment program from the Phoenix Office of Arts and Culture!

About the position

Each student will work 400 hours over the Spring 2023 semester (Jan 1 - May 30, 2023) for \$16 an hour. Organizations will receive an all-inclusive award of \$8,000 to cover salaries, taxes, and other associated costs and fees.

Who can apply?

Organizations must be based in Phoenix and have received a nonprofit arts and culture stabilization grant from POAC in Fall 2021. Organizations must also be able to provide a physical workspace in Phoenix and equipment for students. There are no requirements for supervisors.

Preparing your application

To apply, all you'll need to do is submit a job description and supporting materials through our online application form by August 15, 2022. Info sessions and workshops will be held throughout July and March. Staff are available for one-on-one consultations, too.

Student Workers: 400 hours over the Spring 2023 semester at \$16/hr (~ 20 hrs/wk)

Supervisor Commitment: ~ 5 hrs/week + trainings
