Thank you for your interest in applying for the educational writer-in-residence position with the City of Phoenix Office of Arts and Culture for Spring 2022!

Position Summary

Working closely with staff members at the Phoenix Office of Arts and Culture and English Language Arts specialists at Deer Valley United School District, the educational writer-in-residence will develop creative writing lesson plans, activities, and other resources to get sixth grade students excited about writing at Title I schools. The focus is on narrative writing. The stipend is \$3,500 to \$4,000. The commitment is 8 hours a week from March 1 to May 15, 2022 with at least one day of in-person instruction. While formal teaching experience is required, writers of all backgrounds and experience levels are encouraged to apply. Submitting Your Application

Once you've <u>read the full guidelines</u>, you can apply for the position by completing the following form. To apply for the position, all you'll need is a cover letter or statement of interest, a resume/CV, and up to three references. While you can edit and save your responses in the form, we recommend preparing your application in a separate document and copying and pasting your answers into the form when you're ready. Feel free to download a preview of the application to facilitate this process. The application is expected to take between 15 minutes and 1 hour to complete. Applications close February 20, 2022.

What's next?

Once you submit your application, you'll receive an automated message in your web browser confirming receipt, with an additional confirmation email from the City of Phoenix Office of Arts and Culture once the application period closes. Selected applicants will be contacted for virtual interviews the following week. All applicants will be notified by March 1.
