JULY 29, 2019 (MONDAY)

Latest date to register to vote in the Special Election. *A.R.S. § 16-121.01 and City Code, Sec. 12-106*

JULY 31, 2019 (WEDNESDAY)

Early voting begins at City Hall. *A.R.S. § 16-542 and City Code, Sec. 12-907*

AUGUST 16, 2019 (FRIDAY)

Latest date to request an early ballot by mail. *A.R.S. § 16-542 and City Code, Sec. 12-903*

AUGUST 23, 2019 (FRIDAY)

Latest date to vote early at an early voting location. *A.R.S. § 16-542 and City Code, Sec. 12-907*

AUGUST 27, 2019 (TUESDAY) SPECIAL ELECTION
