AUGUST 2017 COUNCIL ELECTION VOTING AT VOTING CENTERS

Voting at the Voting Centers

Voting Centers will be used for the Phoenix City Council Election. Any eligible voter residing in City Council Districts 2, 4, 6 or 8 may vote at any one of the 18 voting centers. A list of the voting centers with address and general location information is provided below. The list and a map of the voting centers, along with the hours of operation, are also available on the web at <u>Phoenix.gov/Elections</u> and in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet sent to each registered voter's household in late July. For additional assistance locating a voting center that is convenient, voters can use the online locator at <u>Phoenix.gov/Elections</u> or call the Election Information Line at 602-261-VOTE (8683).

Phoenix voters who do not vote by mail are encouraged to visit any one of the 18 voting centers on Saturday, Aug. 26; Monday, Aug. 28; or Tuesday, Aug. 29 to vote in the Council Election. Based on past City elections, Tuesday was the busiest day at the voting centers.

Voter Identification at Voting Centers

Each voter must show proof of identity at a voting center before receiving a ballot. Specific forms of photo or non-photo identification with the voter's name and address are required. The acceptable forms of identification are listed at <u>Phoenix.gov/Elections</u> and in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet. For faster check-in, voters are encouraged to bring their driver's license, state-issued identification card, or voter identification card.

Voters who do not present acceptable identification may vote a Provisional Ballot at a voting center, but may be required to present acceptable identification to an election official by 5 p.m. on the Friday after the election.
