## VOTING AT VOTING CENTERS

### Voting at the Voting Centers

Voting Centers will be used for the Phoenix City Council Election. Any eligible voter residing in City Council Districts 2, 4, 6 or 8 may vote at any one of the 18 voting centers. A list of the voting centers with address and general location information is provided below. The list and a map of the voting centers, along with the hours of operation, are also available on the web at [Phoenix.gov/Elections](http://Phoenix.gov/Elections) and in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet sent to each registered voter's household in late July. For additional assistance locating a voting center that is convenient, voters can use the online locator at [Phoenix.gov/Elections](http://Phoenix.gov/Elections) or call the Election Information Line at 602-261-VOTE (8683).

Phoenix voters who do not vote by mail are encouraged to visit any one of the 18 voting centers on Saturday, Aug. 26; Monday, Aug. 28; or Tuesday, Aug. 29 to vote in the Council Election. Based on past City elections, Tuesday was the busiest day at the voting centers.

### Voter Identification at Voting Centers

Each voter must show proof of identity at a voting center before receiving a ballot. Specific forms of photo or non-photo identification with the voter's name and address are required. The acceptable forms of identification are listed at [Phoenix.gov/Elections](http://Phoenix.gov/Elections) and in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet. For faster check-in, voters are encouraged to bring their driver's license, state-issued identification card, or voter identification card.

Voters who do not present acceptable identification may vote a Provisional Ballot at a voting center, but may be required to present acceptable identification to an election official by 5 p.m. on the Friday after the election.
