#### REDISTRICTING PROCESS

- Required every 10 years
  - to reflect changes in population
  - based on most recent Census
- Schedule & plan approved by City Council
  - same process used as last 3 processes
- Redistricting Consultant selected
  - through procurement process approved by City Council
  - expertise in census data analysis & redrawing boundaries





#### REDISTRICTING PROCESS

#### Dedicated email

- for public comments or questions

#### Dedicated web site

 description, requirements, process, meeting info, maps, census data, public comments, ENG/SPA, etc.

#### Extensive materials created

 business cards w/QR code, FAQ's, meeting schedule flyers, maps (hand outs/posters), comment sheets, etc.





#### REDISTRICTING PROCESS

- Outreach plan created and implemented
  - news releases, PHX newsroom, phoenix.gov, YouTube, social media, resident newsletters, digital newsletters
- Two Rounds of Community Meetings held
  - round 1 (May/June): intro, process, participation, web site
  - round 2 (September): two alternative plans for input
- Residents able to create & submit maps
  - after Round 1 Community Meetings August 1st
- Consultant evaluated all community comments & maps
  - developed a proposed final map





#### REDISTRICTING REQUIREMENTS & GUIDELINES

#### Legal Requirements

- Equal Population
  - Goal: Max deviation <5%; & <1% for individual districts</li>
- Voting Rights Act compliance
  - o preserve minority voting rights









#### City of Phoenix – Total Population by Race and Ethnicity by City Council Districts







