

RESOLUTION 21333

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CREATION OF AN
ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT IN DOWNTOWN PHOENIX
IN ACCORDANCE WITH A.R.S. §4-207.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF PHOENIX as follows:

SECTION 1. That an Entertainment District is hereby created and
designated in Downtown Phoenix in accordance with A.R.S. §4-207.

SECTION 2. That under Arizona law an Entertainment District allows a
municipality's governing body to approve an exemption from the 300' distance
restriction applicable to churches and schools and certain liquor licenses.

SECTION 3. The Entertainment District, a diagram of which is attached
hereto as Attachment A, is approximately 0.92 square miles. The district is generally
bound by I-10 to the north, Hadley Street to the south, 7th Avenue to the west, and 7th
Street to the east; excluding areas consisting primarily of residential, government,
bioscience, convention, or sports structures. The area was found to have a
concentration of entertainment, artistic, and cultural venues and is eligible to be
designated an Entertainment District.


