Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003.**

This meeting will be held for the purpose of discussion and possible action on Complete Streets Design Guidelines for Certain Types of Development within Council District 6, hearing presentations from individuals seeking appointment as the interim council member for District 5, discussion regarding the appointment, and possible action by the City Council to appoint the interim council member. The City Charter requires that the City Council appoint an interim council member by August 2, 2018 to serve until the canvass of votes from a Special Election to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy.
