- The sponsorship dollars are part of the City of Phoenix's annual budget and cannot be spent on travel. There may be other limitations, please inquire for further details.
- The FTC co-chairs will review and pass on requests to the ad hoc committee for a quarterly review.
- If approved, the City of Phoenix will work with your team directly to garner an invoice and process payment and/or any sponsorship documents.
- If the sponsorship includes FTC tabling or providing a service, we will open up volunteer opportunities as needed/appropriate to the general public.
