OAT BACKGROUND

The City of Phoenix created the Office of Accountability and Transparency (OAT) in 2021 to perform independent civilian oversight of the Phoenix Police Department (Department). OAT reviews Department administrative investigations of critical incidents involving sworn personnel and provides community members with a way to freely communicate complaints, commendations, and concerns about officers and the Department without fear of retaliation.

Phoenix City Code (P.C.C.) § 20-1(C) requires OAT to:

- Take community complaints or commendations.
- Establish procedures for receiving anonymous complaints.
- Conduct outreach within the community.
- Support services to community members impacted by the Department.
- Review Department investigations.
- Make recommendations to the Police Chief regarding policy rules and training issues.
- Conduct mediation to resolve disputes.
- Administer a youth outreach program.
- Address other issues of concern to the community.

See P.C.C. [§§ 20-4 through 20-26](#) for additional information about OAT's responsibilities and operations. Chapter 20 was revised in May 2024 and codified in September 2024. This report includes OAT's first quarter updates (January 1 through March 31) in fulfillment of OAT's obligation under P.C.C. § 20-8(C) to publish a quarterly status report.

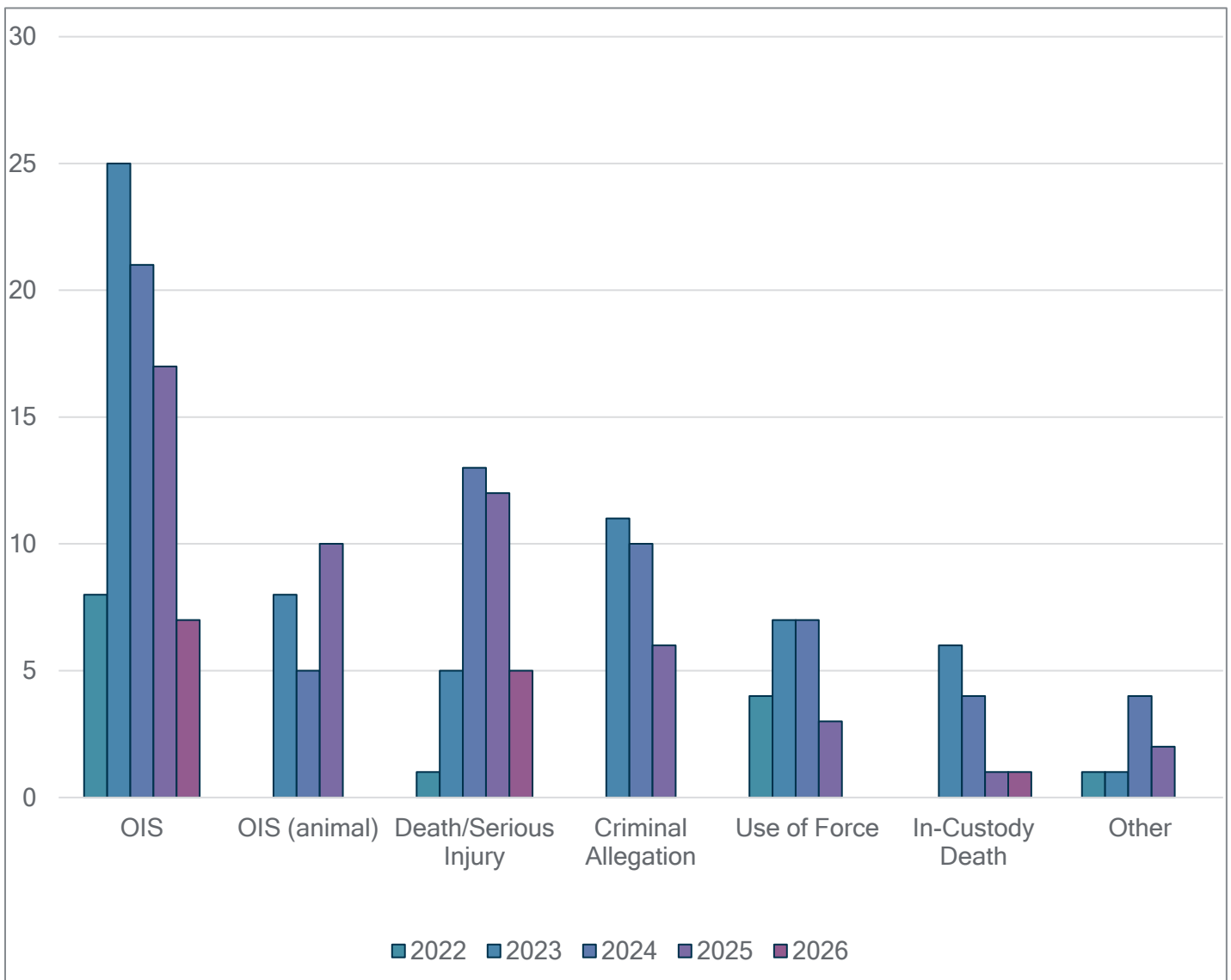
Information sharing between OAT and the Department is governed by a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), first established in 2023 and revised during the first quarter of 2025. The full MOU can be viewed [here](#).

REVIEW CASES

OAT review cases come from complaints filed by the public, media reports, and Department notifications for certain types of incidents (e.g. officer involved shootings). OAT added 14 review cases during the first quarter of 2026, for a total active caseload of 161 (see the Appendix for a list of all active review cases, p. 11).

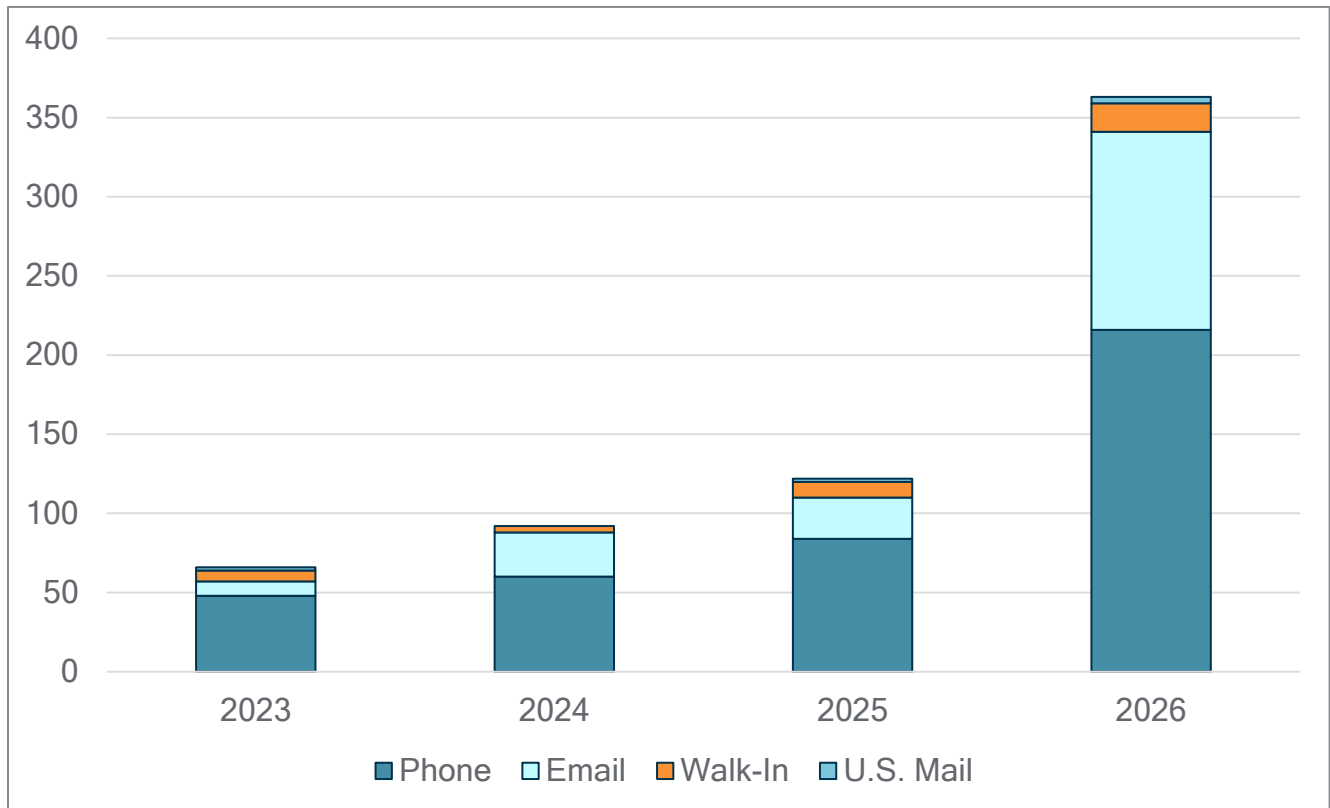
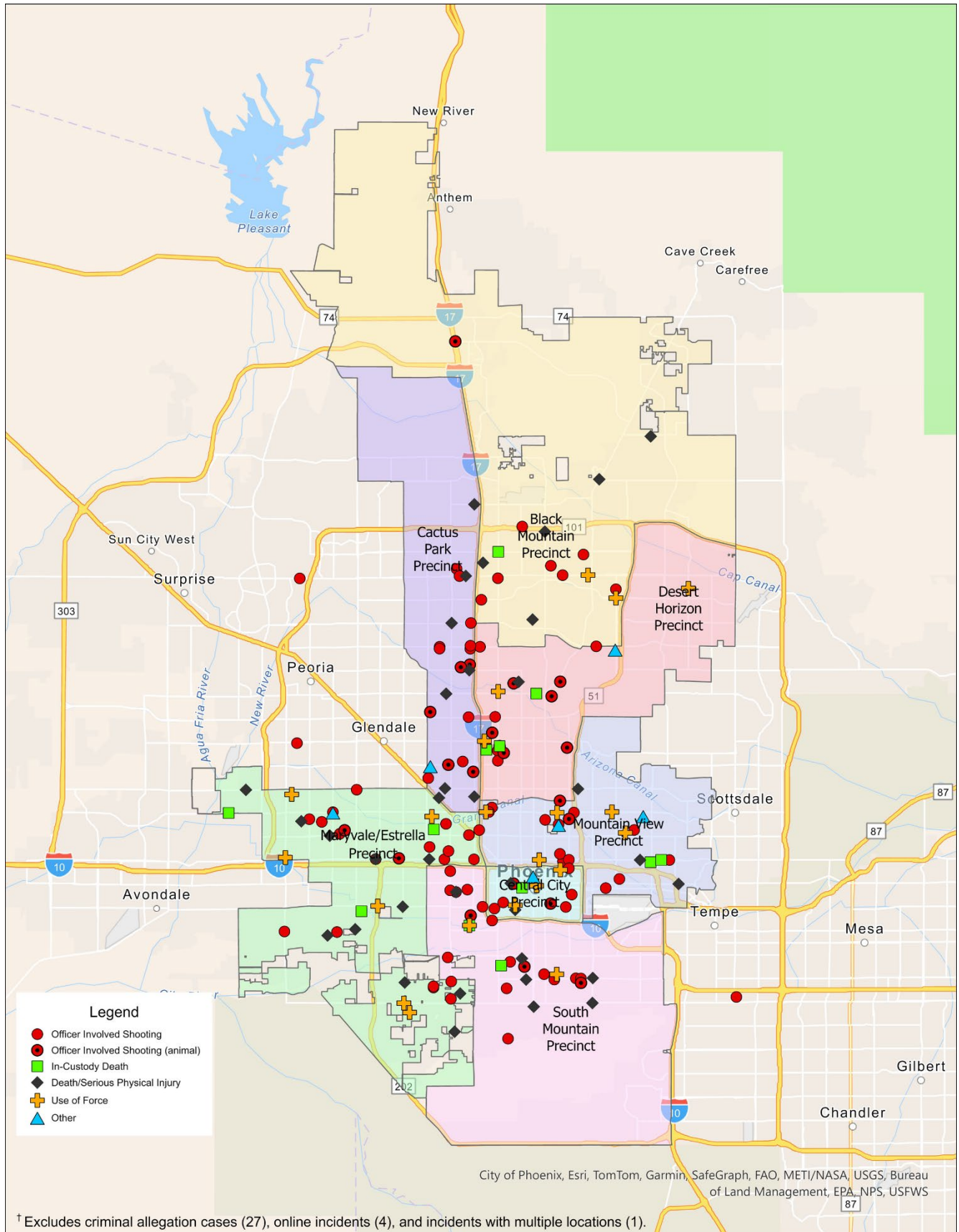


Figure 3: OAT Review Cases by Department Precinct†

Figure 2 below shows all OAT review cases (both active and completed cases) by incident year and type. See Figure 3 on page 6 for a map of all OAT review incidents.

OAT released seven review reports in the first quarter of 2026. The reports reviewed the Department’s administrative investigations of six officer involved shootings, two of which were fatal, and one criminal allegation case involving an officer arrested on domestic violence-related criminal damage and disorderly conduct charges. OAT concluded that five of the seven investigations were thorough and complete, and included recommendations to improve future administrative investigations in three of the reports. The Department agreed with all recommendations. OAT review reports and Department responses can be found on the OAT [website](#).

During the last quarter of 2025, the Department launched a hotline for community members to submit compliments and complaints regarding police employees and services. Non-urgent calls to the hotline are routed to OAT staff. Community members can also contact OAT directly by phone, email, or in person by visiting the OAT office. Between January 1 and March 31, OAT received 363 contacts from community members via phone (216), email (125), walk-in (18), and U.S. mail (4). Of these, 165 were complaint submissions and six were commendations. The remaining 192 contacts were general inquiries. Figure 2 below illustrates trends in OAT contacts since 2023.

Figure 2: OAT Contacts by Year and Type

CIVILIAN REVIEW BOARD

Established in 2024, the Civilian Review Board is tasked with reviewing OAT reports and recommendations to the Department, and then voting to adopt, decline, or table the report pending further information. The Board is comprised of nine members appointed by the Phoenix City Council and meets monthly.

Board meetings in the first half of 2025 were devoted to training on OAT procedures, Department administrative investigations, and relevant legal principles to ensure Board members had the background knowledge required to thoroughly review OAT's reports and recommendations. The Board began reviewing OAT reports and Department responses in September 2025.

During the first quarter of 2026, the Board reviewed four OAT reports and the Department's responses to those reports. The Board voted to adopt OAT's conclusions and recommendations in all four reports.

MEDIATION

In the first quarter of 2026, the OAT mediation program reached a significant milestone with the finalization of the Department's operations order for individual officer mediations. Operations Order 2.2.01, which went into effect March 6, 2026, establishes complaint eligibility criteria, participation requirements, and the Department's responsibilities with respect to the OAT mediation process.

OAT reviews all community complaints submitted to the Department for mediation eligibility and submits eligible complaints to Department leadership for review and approval. Between January and March 2026, OAT identified 76 complaints as potentially appropriate for mediation. Of these, the Department determined that 22 were ineligible for mediation due to the potential discipline level implicated by the allegation, the subject of the complaint not being a Department employee, or the complaint still being under investigation by the Professional Standards Bureau.¹ The Department identified 30 complaints as eligible for mediation, pending officer or Department designee consent to participate. The remaining 24 complaints were still under review by the Department at the end of the quarter. Some complaints under investigation by the Professional Standards Bureau may be considered for mediation following the conclusion of the investigation.

¹ Per Department Operations Order 2.2.01, complaints alleging a policy violation that could result in discipline of a written reprimand or greater are not eligible for mediation.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The OAT Community Engagement team tabled 15 events between January 1 and March 31, 2026, including:

- MLK Celebration at Margaret T. Hance Park
- Matthew Henson Connection Fair
- Maryvale Mercado
- Youth Day at the Capitol
- Unlimited Potential Resource Fair

OAT staff gave seven presentations, conducted 10 meet-and-greets, and made 35 new community engagement contacts via phone, email, and in-person. OAT made 3,025 community member contacts in the first quarter of 2026.



OAT's youth outreach program, Reform Rising, aims to educate, equip, and empower youth regarding law enforcement interactions, civic responsibility, and community advocacy. The pilot class completed the program in November 2025, and the Community Engagement team used the first quarter of 2026 to review the pilot results and revise the program. In March, OAT and Phoenix Union High School District reached a tentative agreement for OAT to administer its youth outreach program at District high schools in the fall of 2026. OAT will continue to work with the District to finalize the agreement and obtain necessary approvals from City Council and the District's governing board.



TRAINING

In the first quarter of 2026, OAT staff attended the following virtual trainings provided by the National Association for Civilian Oversight of Law Enforcement (NACOLE) to enhance and develop their knowledge and skills:

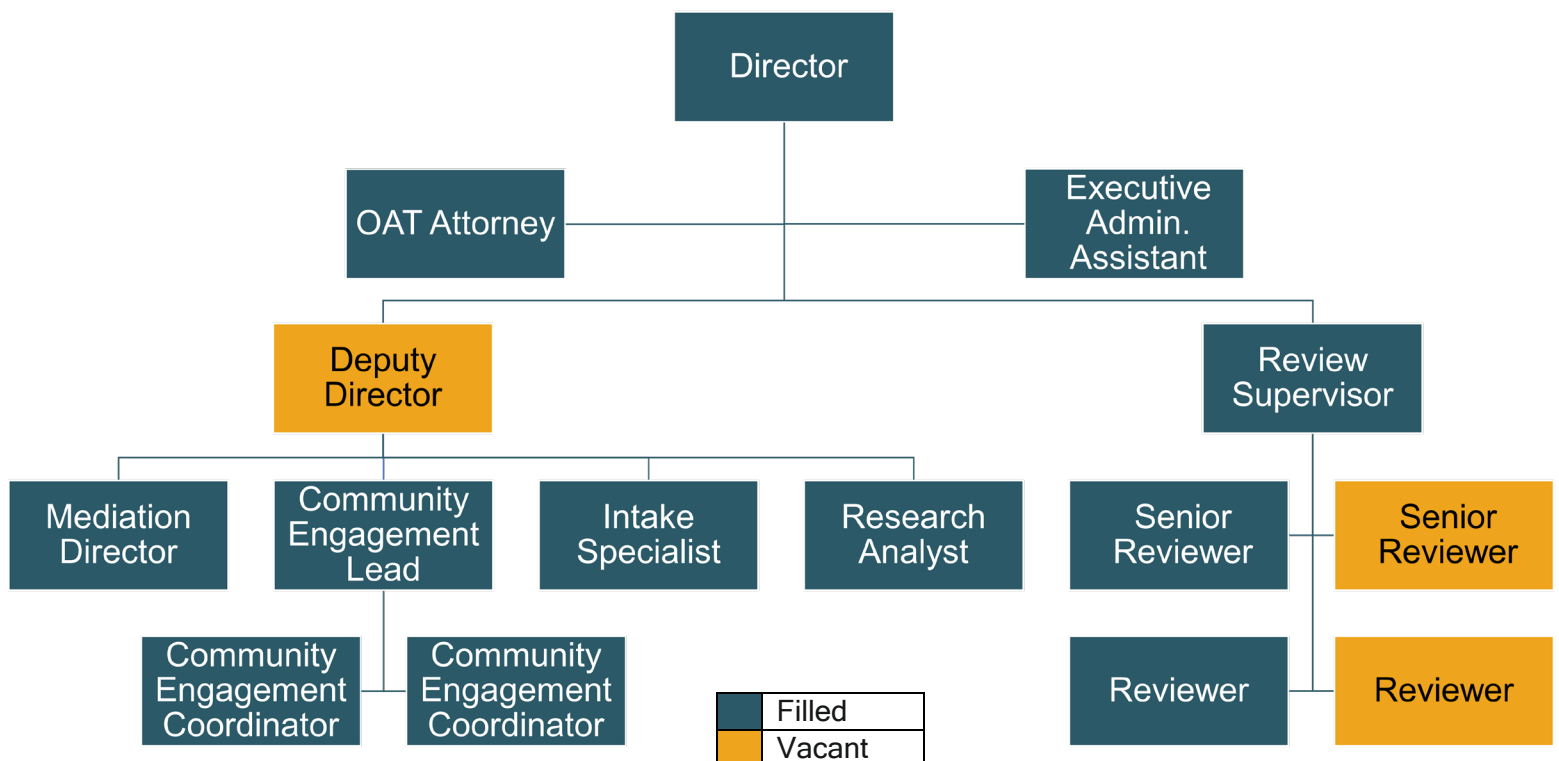
- Immigration Detention: Oversight's Forgotten Space?
