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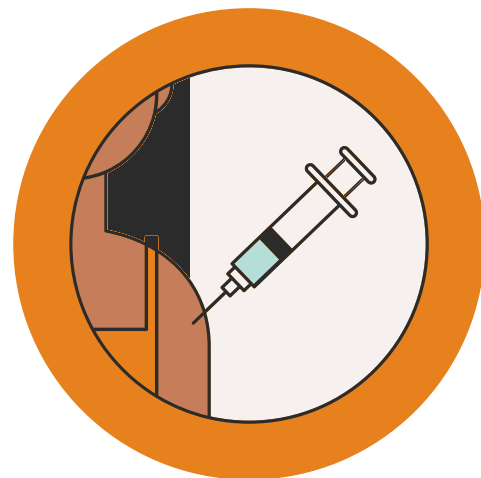

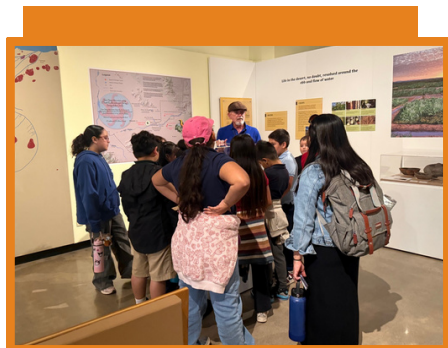
Special Women in Leadership Roundtable

Industrial Maintenance Mechanic Water Services Department

The City of Phoenix Water Services Department provides safe, reliable drinking water to 1.5 million customers and manages wastewater services for 2.5 million residents.

The Water Production Division is hiring Industrial Maintenance Mechanics (IMMs) to install, repair, and maintain mechanical equipment such as pumps, blowers, valves, and gearboxes used across treatment plants, wells, pumping stations, and reservoirs.

IMMs handle diverse mechanical work, including fabrication and millwright tasks, and may lead assigned projects. Current openings are at the Lake Pleasant and 24th Street Water Treatment Plants.

Ideal candidates are dependable team players who can work outdoors in various conditions, operate in confined spaces or at heights over 10 feet, and safely lift up to 50 pounds.
