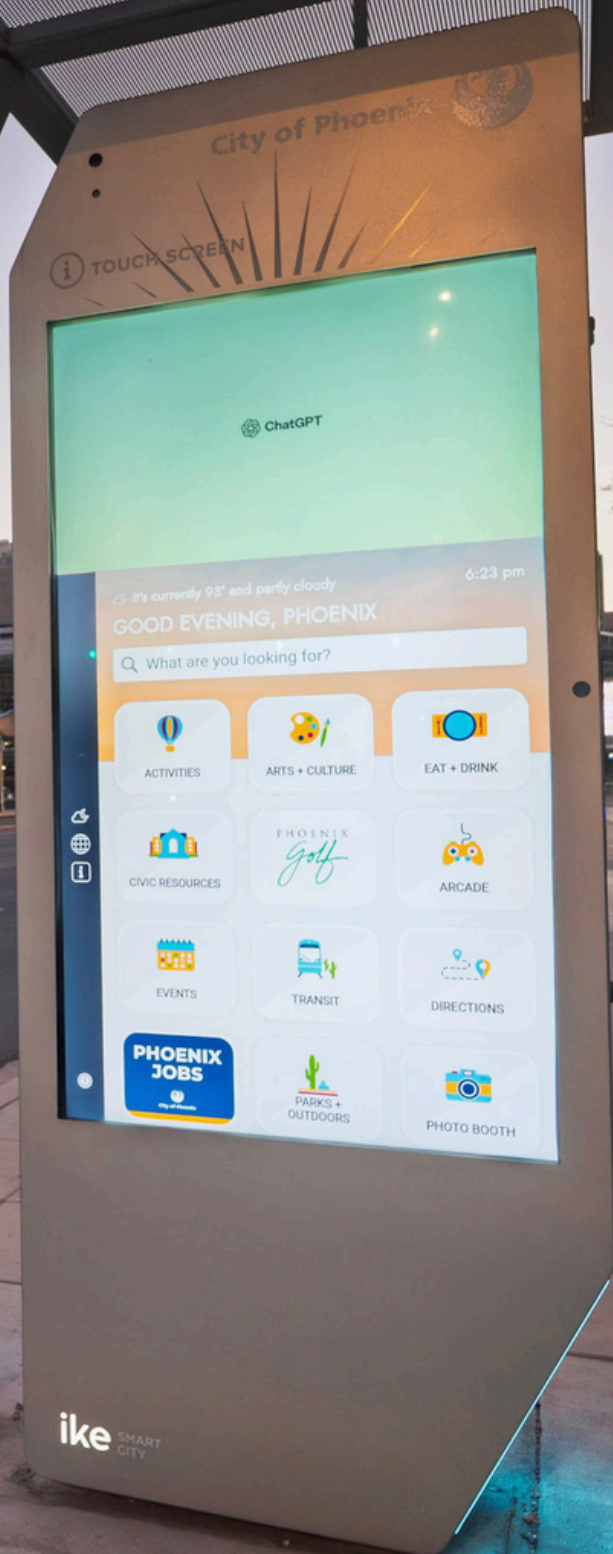

Congratulations to Public Works' Solid Waste Division, which just took home the **2026 Project of the Year Award** from the American Public Works Association!

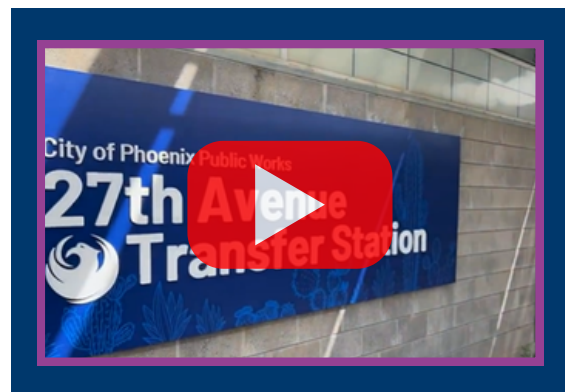


The award recognized the multi-year renovation of the 27th Avenue Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), which is where recyclables are sorted, baled, and eventually shipped off to manufacturers.

The original MRF was built in 1998, but now the facility has brand-new sorting machinery filled with the latest technology -- including optical sorters, a giant trommel, eddy currents, and a sorting robot -- to make the sorting process even more accurate and efficient.

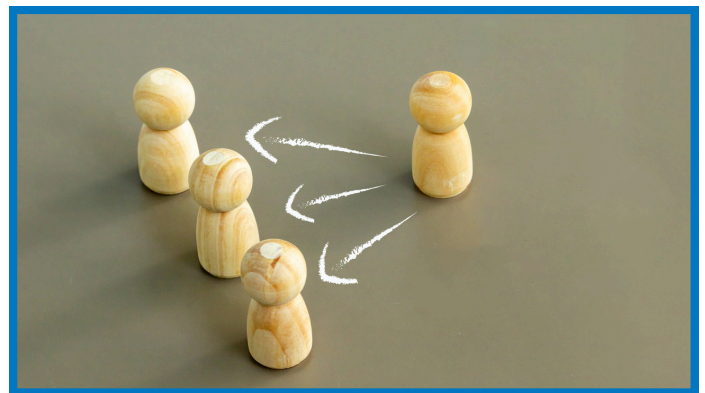

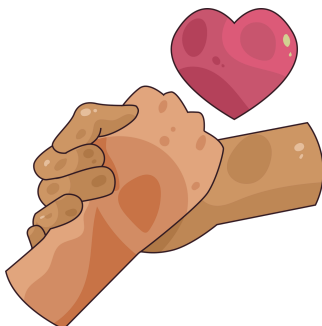
Their findings give investigators the tools they need to solve crimes and, most importantly, bring justice to victims and their families.

Accounting Supervisor Finance Department

The Finance Department is seeking an enthusiastic and professional Accounting Supervisor to join the Financial Accounting & Reporting Division (FAR).

This position offers substantial professional discretion within the framework of GAAP and City policies. Working under the general direction of a Fiscal Manager, key responsibilities include supervising professional accounting and finance staff, directing financial reporting activities such as the City's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR), establishing division policies and procedures, implementing new GASB pronouncements, and advising departments on technical accounting matters.

Ideal candidates are adaptable and comfortable managing change, experienced in large ERP environments, and well-versed in accounting principles that drive financial reporting. They should have experience preparing journal entries and financial statements, working with auditors, and leading diverse teams. Strong critical thinking, communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills are essential, along with the ability to build trust, collaborate effectively, and translate business needs into actionable guidance.
