Just Days Left for Kudos Cards

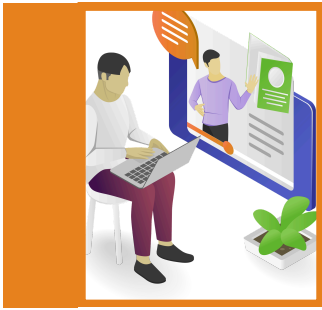


If you have not yet **filled out your digital 602 Day Kudos Cards** - you have until **Friday, May 29** to ensure digital delivery by June 2.

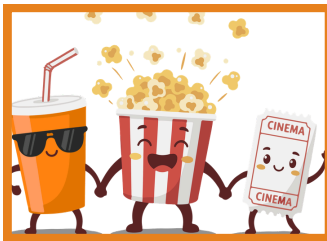
DUE: Annual Policy Acknowledgment

Calling All City of Phoenix Dads



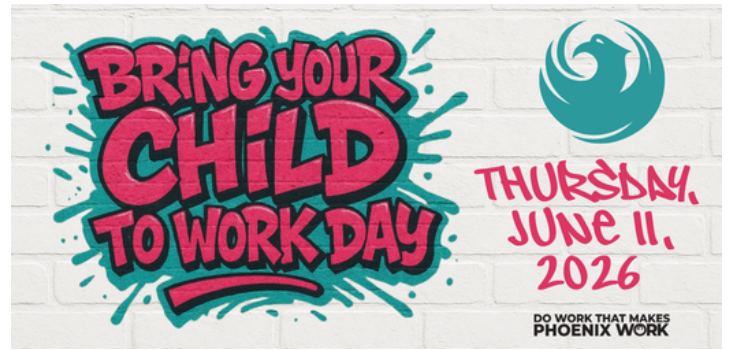

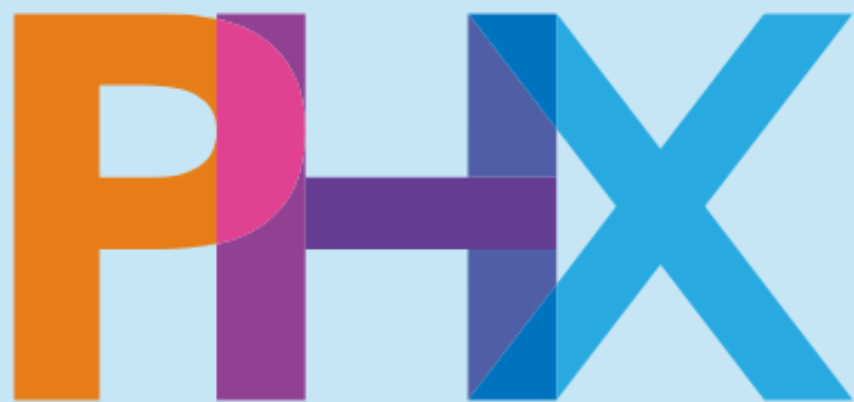
