

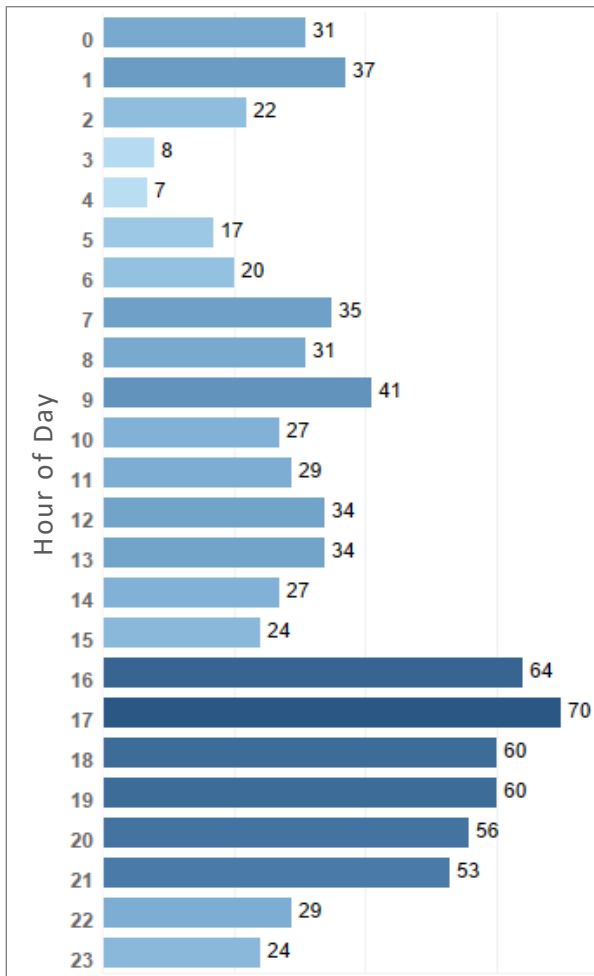

### Intake Time



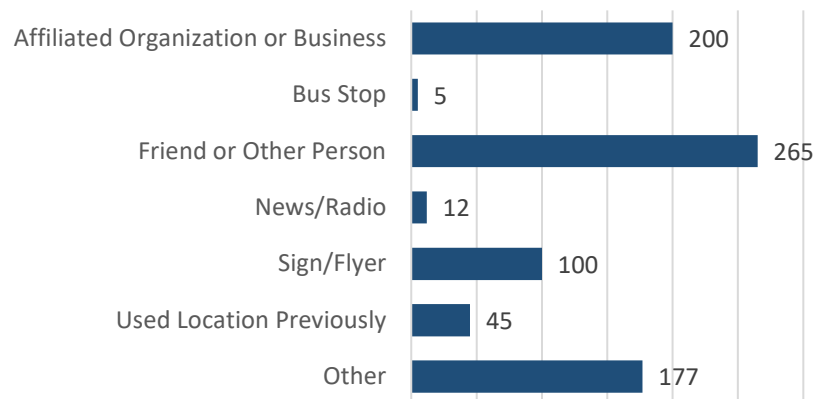

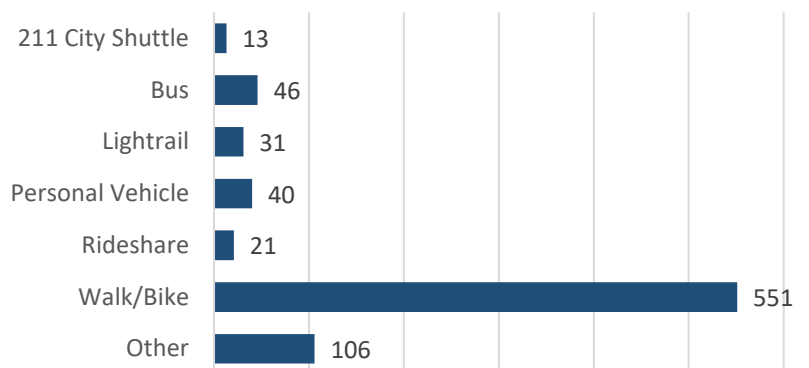
### Phoenix Summer Safety Operation Totals 5/1/25 – 5/21/25:

- **67 heat related** calls for service (Source: Phoenix FD).
- **1,779 visits** in respite and extended hour cooling centers (based on intake forms received).
- Overall, **noon and between the hours of 4 and 8 pm** have seen the highest number of people arriving.
- **Walk/Bike (66%)** is the most popular method of getting to the cooling center.
- **1,336 visits (82%)** indicated they are experiencing homelessness.
- **495 visits** indicated they had used some type of drug within 24-hours of arriving at the cooling/respite center.
- **331 visitors** received direct onsite assistance from CBI with various shelter or homeless solutions referrals. **1 visitor** required additional follow up for their referral, which was submitted by the Office of Emergency Management on their behalf.

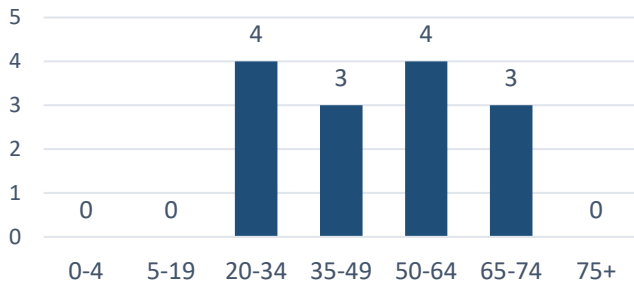

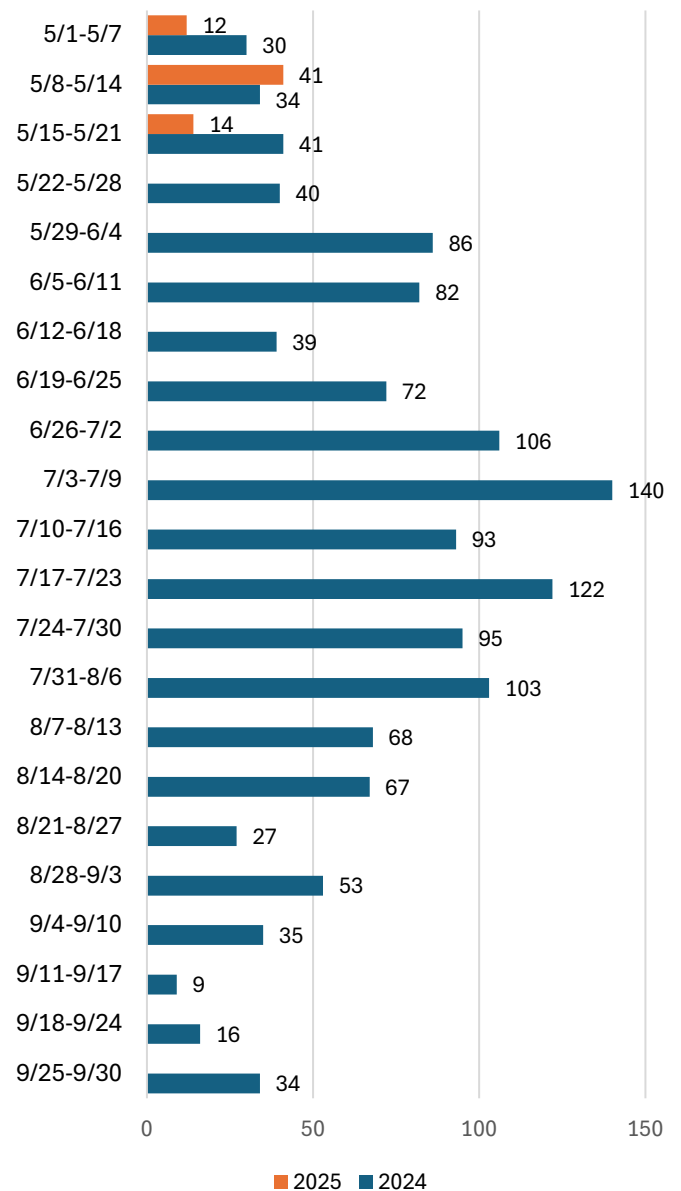

21% of patients who suffered from heat related illness were experiencing homelessness.

The average high for the third week of the heat relief operation was 94 degrees (compared to 98 degrees the same time last year).

There were 14 heat related calls for service the third week of the heat relief operation, 5/15-5/21 compared to 41 calls for service last year.
