RIO SALADO DISTRICT POLICY PLAN AND GENERAL PLAN LAND USE MAP
AMENDMENT – NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING**

Pursuant to A.R.S. Section 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the **CENTRAL CITY AND SOUTH MOUNTAIN VILLAGE PLANNING COMMITTEES**, and to the general public, that the **CENTRAL CITY** and **SOUTH MOUNTAIN VILLAGE PLANNING COMMITTEES**, as well as the general public, have been invited to the Rio Salado District Policy Plan and General Plan Land Use Map Amendment Neighborhood Meeting, hosted by the City of Phoenix, Planning and Development Department. This event takes place on **Wednesday, May 20, 2026, from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.**

This event will be held in-person at the Travis L. Williams Family Services Center, at 4732 South Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85040.

The City of Phoenix has filed two Major General Plan Amendment cases on approximately 4,482 acres generally encompassed by Interstate 17 (north), 32nd Street (east), Broadway Road (south), and 19th Avenue (west). The first case (**Case No. GPA-CC-SM-1-26-7-8**) is for the Rio Salado District Policy Plan (RIO PHX), while the second case (**Case No. GPA-CC-SM-2-26-7-8**) is an amendment to update the General Plan Land Use Map to be consistent with the proposed Rio Salado District Policy Plan.

During the neighborhood meeting, staff will present an overview of the Rio Salado District Policy Plan and amendment to the General Plan Land Use Map to be consistent with the proposed Rio Salado District Policy Plan, intended to provide guidance on future development and growth within the area. Attendees will be able to interact with and provide comments on the plan and land use map amendment. For additional details see: www.phoenix.gov/pdd/riophx.
