**Thank you for providing us with amazing hospitality and encouraging community connections.**

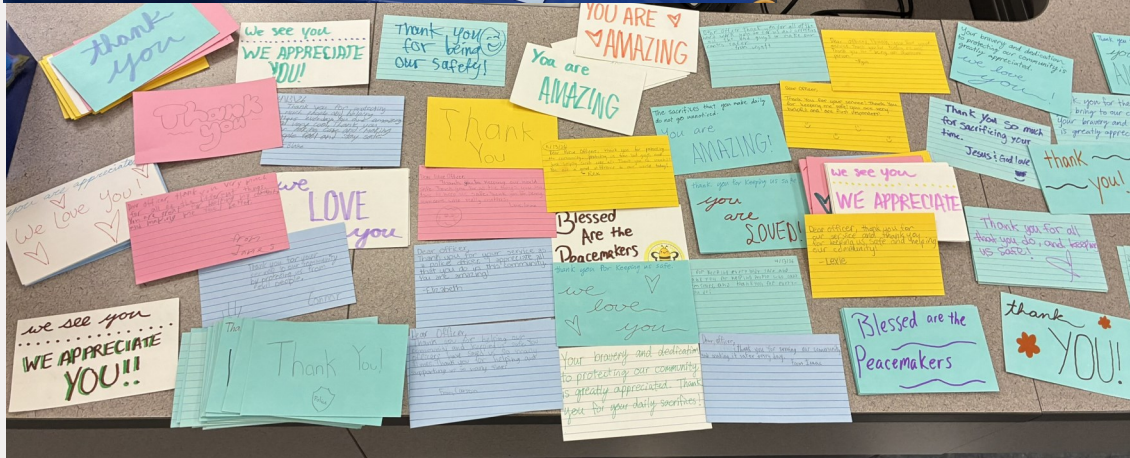
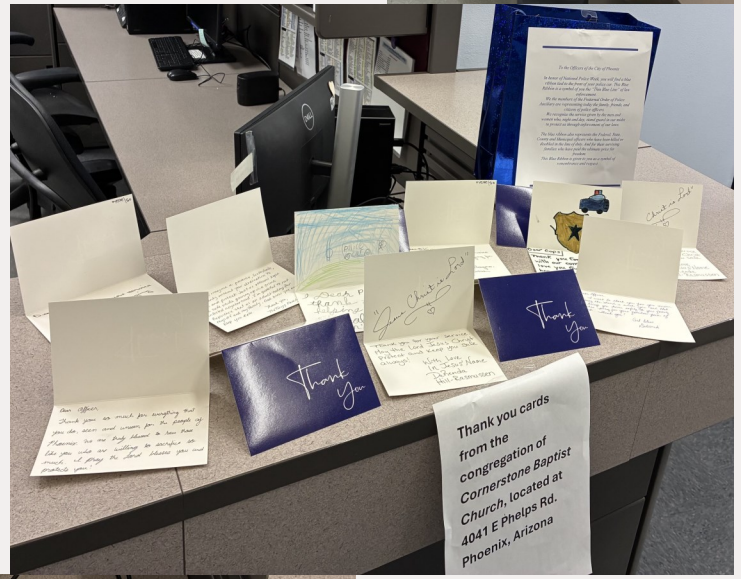
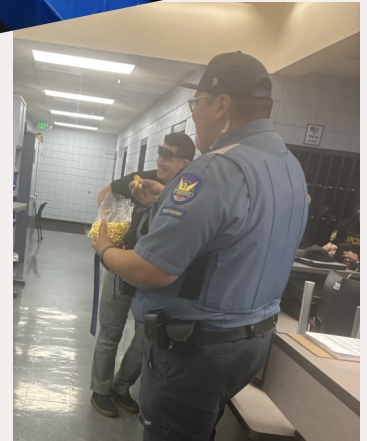
# NATIONAL POLICE WEEK

## ***DONATIONS FOR FAMILIES DISPLACED***

### **500 CAO SQUAD GATHERS DONATIONS FOR DISPLACED FAMILIES IN NEED**



When crisis strikes, our officers show what it truly means to support one another. Recently, an impaired driver crashed into a city-owned apartment building, displacing two families with young children. Because of the extensive damage, both families had to evacuate immediately, leaving behind all of their belongings.

The city's Housing Department relocated the families into nearby vacant units but the families were still left without any essential items. The Community Action Officer (CAO) squad from Central City Precinct stepped in, coordinating an immediate donation effort to help meet the families' basic needs.



Thanks to the generosity and partnership of the Phoenix Law Enforcement Association, Phoenix Police Sergeants and Lieutenants Association, the City of Phoenix Office of Homeless Solutions, Angels on Patrol, Chick-fil-A on 7th Avenue & Roosevelt Street, and the Phoenix Revitalization Corporation, the families received groceries, household items,

toiletries, clothing and gift cards to help them rebuild. The CAOs even helped one family in finding their missing cat, which had been lost during the incident.

We are so grateful for our staff and partners who came together so quickly to support these families during an incredibly difficult time.

To our officers, your compassion made a tough situation a little easier and showcased the strength of our community when it mattered most.

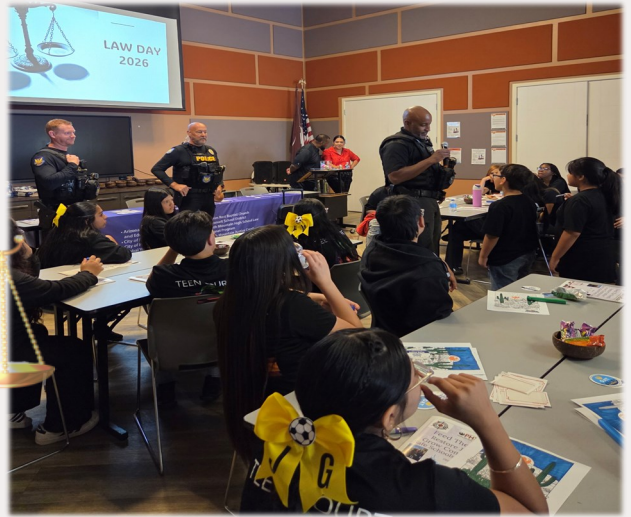


# LAW DAY 2026

Law Day is celebrated annually in May by the Arizona Judicial Branch and is often highlighted through special Teen Court events. # TRAVELING SKY HARBOR

**Summer travel** is right around the corner, and Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport is preparing to welcome travelers and family groups heading out on long-awaited vacations. The airport will also see fans flying from PHX to support their favorite teams in major international soccer matches across the country in June and July. With so many different groups on the move, America's Friendliest Airport® is reminding everyone that a little preparation goes a long way.

**Plan Parking Before You Go:** If you plan to park at the airport, book your spot early at [skyharbor.com/parking](https://skyharbor.com/parking). Spaces fill quickly during peak travel periods. Even with a reservation, allow extra time to park and reach your terminal.

**Pack with Purpose:** Before you pack your suitcase, visit the [TSA's "What Can I Bring?" page](#). A quick review so you don't pack prohibited items in your carry-on can help prevent delays at the checkpoint.

**Check Your Flight Status:** Before leaving home, confirm your flight details with your airline. Knowing your flight status ahead of time can help you avoid surprises.

**Arrive with Time to Spare:** Plan to arrive at least two hours before a domestic flight and at least three hours ahead of an international departure. Early arrival is one of the easiest ways to reduce stress, especially when traveling with children or groups.

**Use Early Bag Check:** Travelers using the PHX Sky Train® can take advantage of [Early Bag Check](#) at the Rental Car Center and East Economy Parking. This free service allows passengers flying domestically on select airlines to check their bags before entering the terminal and skip airline ticket counter lines to save time. It is especially helpful for families and seniors. Car seats or sporting equipment must be checked at the airline ticket counter.

## Support For Travelers with Special Needs

Created as a dedicated space for travelers with special needs or sensory challenges, the Compassion Corner on Level 3 of Terminal 4 near the B elevators includes an all-faiths chapel, an office that assists passengers with accessibility needs, and a sensory room that offers a quiet break from the busy terminal environment.

Passengers who may need a little extra time or assistance can request a [Compassion Cacti™ lanyard](#) before their flight. This lanyard discreetly alerts airport staff that someone in the party may benefit from added support. Travelers can also schedule a [Navigator Support Guide](#) for help throughout the airport experience.

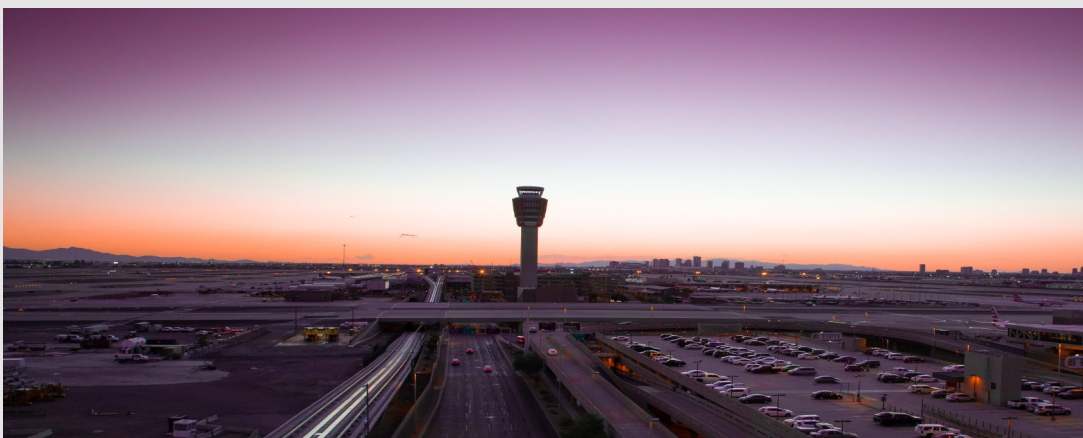
**TSA now offers an alternative.** [TSA ConfirmID](#) provides a modern, fee-based identity verification process that helps passengers move forward with their journey even when their ID is unavailable.

Phoenix Sky Harbor offers several options to help expedite the security checkpoint process for travelers.

Travelers without TSA PreCheck can use [PHX RESERVE](#), a free program that lets you schedule a security screening time in advance. Reservations are available up to six days ahead at [skyharbor.com/PHXRESERVE](https://skyharbor.com/PHXRESERVE).

[TSA PreCheck® Touchless ID](#) is available in both terminals and uses facial recognition to verify identity so passengers can move through screening without pulling out a physical ID. Participation is an opt-in feature through your airline. [CLEAR+](#) members now have access to new eGates, which use biometric technology for a streamlined identity check.

**Airport Conditions and Roadway Restrictions** To help meet future passenger demand, several major construction projects are currently underway that require temporary roadway restrictions at the airport. Visit our [Roadway Restrictions](#) page for construction-related traffic updates.
