Pedestrian Dies After Being Struck By Vehicle

(October 31, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a north valley collision that left a man dead.

On October 30, 2025, around 7:35 p.m., officers responded to the area of 32nd Street and Campo Bello Drive regarding collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located the adult male pedestrian, later identified as 84-year-old Edward Pickles, with serious injuries. Pickles was transported to a nearby hospital, but he did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The vehicle involved remained on scene after the collision.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. The preliminary investigation indicates that Pickles was crossing 32nd Street, mid-block, when he was struck by the vehicle involved. Impairment is not believed to be a factor in this collision at this time. Final charging decisions will be made once the accident reconstruction process is complete. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
