Man Dies Day After Southside Collision

(November 16, 2025) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating an evening collision that left a man dead.

On November 15, 2025, around 7:30 p.m., officers responded to the area of 27th Avenue and Buckeye Road regarding collision resulting in injuries. When officers arrived, they located two adult male occupants, both drivers of the involved vehicles, with serious injuries. One man was transported to a nearby hospital with serious injuries. He remains in the hospital receiving treatment. The second man, identified as 32-year-old Juan Pineda Ventura, was also transported to a nearby hospital with life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. The scene investigation was conducted, and the area was opened up. The initial man transported to the hospital was processed for being impaired at the time of the collision. On November 16, 2025, Pineda Ventura succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

The preliminary investigation indicates that the vehicle driven by Pineda Ventura was traveling eastbound on Buckeye Road when it entered the intersection at 27th Avenue on a green light. The vehicle driven by the other man was traveling southbound on 27th Avenue and ran the red light hitting the vehicle driven by Pineda Ventura.

Charging decisions related to this investigation will be decided once toxicology results are available and the accident reconstruction process is complete. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
