Man Hospitalized in Critical Condition After Motorcycle Wreck

(November 23, 2025) Officers were called to a collision just after midnight that left a motorcyclist in the hospital with critical injuries.

At about 12:35 a.m., on Saturday morning, officers responded to a collision in the area of 1600 East Van Buren Street. As officers got to the scene, they located an adult male motorcyclist suffering from serious injuries. Phoenix Fire responded and took the man to the hospital in critical condition. The driver of the involved car stayed on scene and did not show any signs of intoxication.

Detective responded to the scene and learned that the motorcyclist was driving west on Van Buren Street approaching 16th Street when the adult female driver of a car failed to yield from a stop sign had pulled onto Van Buren and struck the victim.
