Aggravated Assault Investigation

Around 1:30 a.m., Phoenix Police officers were notified by Department of Public Safety (DPS) troopers that they heard rapid gunfire coming from the area of North 27th Avenue and Bethany Home Road. DPS arrived first and found several people in front of a business. Phoenix Police officers responded to assist, and four adult men, ages 18 to 20, were located with gunshot wounds.

Phoenix Fire personnel responded and transported all four men to the hospital with serious injuries. One man was listed in critical condition. The scene was secured, and witnesses reported that the injured men had been involved in an argument that escalated into an exchange of gunfire.

Detectives are working to determine the extent of each person's involvement and whether any of the injured individuals may have been bystanders.
