## Fatal Pedestrian Collision

On April 9th, 2026, at approximately 7:33 p.m., officers responded to the area of 25th Street and Roosevelt St for a reported collision involving a pedestrian in a wheelchair. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male pedestrian with serious injuries. He was transported by Phoenix Fire Personnel to a local hospital with life-threatening injuries. The driver of the car involved remained on scene.

Detectives from the Vehicular Crimes Unit responded and assumed the investigation. Preliminary information suggests the man in the wheelchair entered the roadway and may have been impaired. The driver of the car tried to avoid him, but was unable to, resulting in the collision. The driver was evaluated for impairment and showed no signs of being impaired.

On April 11, 2026, the pedestrian died from his injuries. He has not yet been identified.

This investigation remains ongoing. Any potential charges will be determined upon the completion of the investigation.
