Fatal Collision

Around 8:54 p.m., officers responded to the area of 27th Avenue and Yorkshire Drive regarding a collision involving a motorcycle. When officers arrived, they located the adult driver of the motorcycle, later identified as 25-year-old Kendra Lenae Harrison, in critical condition. The Phoenix Fire Department arrived on the scene and transported Harrison to a nearby hospital, where she was pronounced deceased. The driver of the involved vehicle remained at the scene.

Detectives from the Vehicular Crimes Unit responded to assume and process the scene. Preliminary information indicates Harrison was southbound on 27th Avenue when the driver of the vehicle turned left in front of Harrison. The driver of the vehicle was stopped at the red light on 27th Avenue facing north. The light turned green and the driver thought it was a green turn arrow and proceeded to make the turn; however, the turn arrow was red. The driver of the vehicle was evaluated for impairment and no signs were observed. Additional information related to this incident remains a part of the ongoing investigation. Final charging decisions will be made when the reconstruction is completed by detectives.
