## OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING

### UPDATE:

(June 12, 2026) The suspect in this case has been identified as 56-year-old **James Glenn**. Further information remains part of the ongoing investigation.

### ORIGINAL INFO:

On June 11, 2026, just before 6:00 p.m., Phoenix Police officers from the Tactical Support Bureau were in the area of North 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and West Pinnacle Peak Road following a man in a vehicle with a felony warrant in connection with an investigation involving sexual conduct with a minor.

A K-9 officer used a vehicle interdiction device known as a grappler to stop the suspect vehicle on Pinnacle Peak, just west of 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Another officer contained the suspect by using his vehicle to pin the driver's door. While seated in his vehicle, officers reported seeing the suspect raise a gun and pointed it at them. This is when the officer-involved shooting took place. Both officers fired their duty weapons, striking the suspect.

Once it was deemed safe to approach, the suspect was removed from the vehicle. Phoenix Fire personnel responded and pronounced him deceased on the scene. A handgun was recovered from the suspect vehicle. No officers or community members were injured during this incident.
