Fatal Collision

On February 6th, 2026, around 8:47 p.m., officers responded to the area of 2400 West Williams Drive after receiving reports of a single vehicle collision. Phoenix Fire Department personnel and Phoenix police officers arrived on scene and located the car, along with a driver and passenger who had sustained serious injuries. Both adult male occupants were transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries. The driver, later identified as 56-year-old Ricardo Campos Garcia, did not survive, and was pronounced deceased at the hospital. The passenger remains hospitalized in serious condition.

Detectives from the Vehicular Crimes Unit responded to take over the investigation and process the scene. Preliminary information indicates the driver failed to stop at a stop sign in the area and collided with a wall. Impairment has not been determined at this time; however, speed is believed to be a contributing factor. This investigation remains ongoing.
