Domestic Dispute Leaves One Dead

(January 12, 2026) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a stabbing that left a man dead.

On January 11, 2026, at around 11:46 p.m., officers responded to the area of 17th Place and Cambridge Avenue regarding a stabbing. When Officers arrived on the scene, they located one adult male, later identified as Timotheus Keshon Hampton, suffering from at least one stab wound. The Phoenix Fire Department arrived on the scene and transported Timotheus to a nearby hospital, where he was pronounced deceased. Officers also made contact with an adult male, later identified as Ali-Ondre Hampton, the brother involved in the incident.

Homicide and Night detectives responded to assume the investigation and begin processing the scene. Preliminary information suggests the brothers were in an altercation when the stabbing occurred. Ali-Ondre was transported to headquarters for questioning, where he was eventually booked into jail for murder. Additional details related to this incident remain a part of the ongoing investigation.
