UPDATE: January 5, 2026

Since the beginning of this investigation, Homicide detectives have worked diligently to identify and locate the involved suspects in this homicide. On January 2, 2026, two suspects were identified and ultimately located. Each was booked on charges stemming from the investigation. The first suspect, identified as 20-year-old Daniel Zamora, was booked on charges of murder and aggravated assault. The second suspect, 29-year-old Ricky Zamora, was booked for hindering prosecution.

This remains an active investigation with the possibility of additional suspects being involved. Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip. Rewards will be paid for information leading to an arrest in this case.

Mid-Day Shooting Leaves Man Dead Another Hospitalized

(January 3, 2026) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating an afternoon shooting that left one man dead and another in the hospital.

On January 2, 2026, at around 1:30 p.m., officers responded to the area of 19th Avenue and Bell Road regarding a shooting call. When officers arrived, they found two adult males with at least one gunshot wound each. Both men were transported to nearby hospitals. One man remains in the hospital in serious but stable condition. The second man, identified as 25-year-old Manuel Fonseca, did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Phoenix Police Homicide Detectives responded to assume the investigation. Additional details related to this incident remain part of the ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip. Rewards will be paid for information leading to an arrest in this case.
