Man in Custody After Trespassing and Destroying Memorial

(September 14, 2025): A man is in custody after trespassing onto the grounds of a private business and destroying a community memorial.

On September 14, 2025, at approximately 9:50 a.m., officers were directed to a man who was seen damaging a community memorial in front of a business near 48th Street and Beverly Road. Officers were in the area to assist with traffic control due to a large community presence in the area following recent events.

The man, later identified as 19-year-old Ryder Corral, was detained by witnesses until he was taken into custody by responding officers. There are no serious injuries to report.

Corral will be booked on multiple charges to include criminal damage, trespassing, and disorderly conduct. An updated media advisory will be sent out once Corral is booked and a booking number is available.
