Man Shot and Killed in North Phoenix

(June 1, 2024): A man is facing homicide charges for shooting and killing a man by a bus stop after a verbal argument.

Around 11:30 p.m., officers were called to a shooting at Tatum Boulevard and Union Hills Drive. When officers arrived, they found a man suffering from a gunshot wound next to a bus stop. Officers provided aid to the man until the fire department arrived. The man, later identified as 49-year-old Nathan Page, died from his injuries on scene. Officers were able to speak to witnesses and reviewed surveillance footage from a nearby convenience store that led them to the suspect who possibly lived nearby.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation and followed leads that resulted in the identification and arrest of 31-year-old Arbron Mehaj. Detectives also secured search warrants which resulted in additional evidence and probable cause to book Mehaj into the Maricopa County Jail for Second Degree Murder. The investigation remains active.
